## RoHS compliance

The RoHS Directive 2011/65/EU with amending Commission Delegated Directive (EU) 2015/863 together with the WEEE Directive 2012/19/EU concerns manufacturers and importers of electronics and electrical equipment and is part of the general EU environmental policy.

The purpose of the RoHS Directive is to restrict the use of certain forbidden substances such as:

- Lead (Pb)
- Mercury (Hg)
- Cadmium (Cd)
- Hexavalent chromium (Cr6+)
- Polybrominated biphenyls (PBB)
- Polybrominated diphenyl ether (PBDE)
- Bis(2-ethylhexyl) phthalate (DEHP)
- Butyl benzyl phthalate (BBP)
- Dibutyl phthalate (DBP)
- Diisobutyl phthalate (DIBP)

The company DAFA has high standards for human health and environmental awareness and declares to comply with the requirements in RoHS.

It is the policy of the company DAFA to fully comply with the RoHS legislation and to work closely with suppliers and customers in this matter. The compliance is a part of DAFA's policy to keep the customers fully informed of the company's health and environmental commitment.
